

Students should bring:

- Fine Silver wire 18-26 gauge, wire gauge depends on fabrication/ construction technique to be used.
- Pliers-a full assortment:
- Parallel pliers are a must. My favorite pliers are:
- Tronex P517/P717 Chain nose/ round nose combo pliers
- Parallel pliers – flat nose, non-serrated. (I have the basic Rio Grande pair)

The following items will be supplied by the Lighthouse and FSG.

Students are welcome to bring enamels, sifters, brushes, and wire if they have their own supply.

- Copper and Iron wire 18-26 gauge, wire gauge depends on fabrication/ construction technique to be used.
- Enameling Set-Up: Kiln, trivets, fork, screens, sifters, magazines, klyr-fire, brushes and containers
- Enamels: Liquid Enamels and powder enamels – we won't need a lot of colors, but a few of each would be nice.

- GC-16- ground coat for iron
- BC-303L- medium fusing clear
- Thompson Enamels for sifting:
- 1996- black
- 1010- white
- 1820-Goldenrod Yellow
- 1880-Flame red
- 2020- clear transparent flux
- 2325- gem green
- 2625- winter blue
- 2910- elan grey
