

# Stone Within a Stone with Ryan Gardner

## Materials

At least two stones, one smaller than the other. These can be any size you feel comfortable working with. (we suggest you do not choose stones that are very small (under 20mm)

Bezel wire appropriate for each stone.

Silver Sheet for back plate, 24g. or 20g.

Silver solder; hard, med and easy.

## Tools

Torch for soldering (Flux, pick, pickle)

Flex shaft - Foredom or equivalent

Flat nose pliers

Half round pliers

Needle nose pliers

Tweezers

Shears

Ruler

Jewelers saw and blades

Glass dish for water
